



OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST GRADE I

St. Joseph's General Hospital, located in Comox on Vancouver Island, has a high need for casual Occupational Therapists. Responsible to the Coordinator of Rehabilitation Services, the Occupational Therapist assesses, implements, documents and evaluates treatments to facilitate the rehabilitation of referred patients. Communication with the referring physicians and other health care team members is essential in implementation and coordination of the care plan.

Applicants must have graduated from an accredited Occupational Therapy program which meets the requirements of the College of Occupational Therapy of British Columbia (COTBC). Current registration with COTBC is required.

Areas of practice include: inpatient medical and surgical services including coverage in emergency and pediatrics. There is also an opportunity to work in outpatient services for applicants with experience and interest in this area.

The Occupational Therapy department at St. Joseph's General Hospital consists of energetic and motivated individuals. We have a strong interest in providing best practice in our patient care plans and we are continually working on program development.
